SCOPE OF THE CONFERENCE

The conference covers a broad range of mineral engineering topics, including mineral processing, its fundamentals, and process technology. The Organizers and sponsors of the MEC 2026 Conference invite you to submit papers in the fields of surface physicochemistry, mineralogical analysis, geometallurgy, bio- and hydrometallurgy, waste management, the production and testing of aggregates, and ecology.

The Conference presentations may have fundamental as well as applied (utilitarian) aspects. The conference aims to showcase the latest achievements from research centers and to integrate communities involved in mineral engineering research and the utilization of mineral and secondary raw materials (wastes).

CALL FOR PAPERS

Submitted abstracts of papers/presentations will be published in the conference proceedings. Furthermore, papers that successfully pass the peer-review process will be recommended for publication in a special issue of the journal **Physicochemical Problems of Mineral Processing** (IF = 1.2). The publication fee is included in the MEC 2026 conference fee.



Full participation includes up to 2 abstracts in the Conference proceedings and allows two oral presentations.

A prize will be awarded for the best presentation by a Young Scientist (under 35 years of age).
